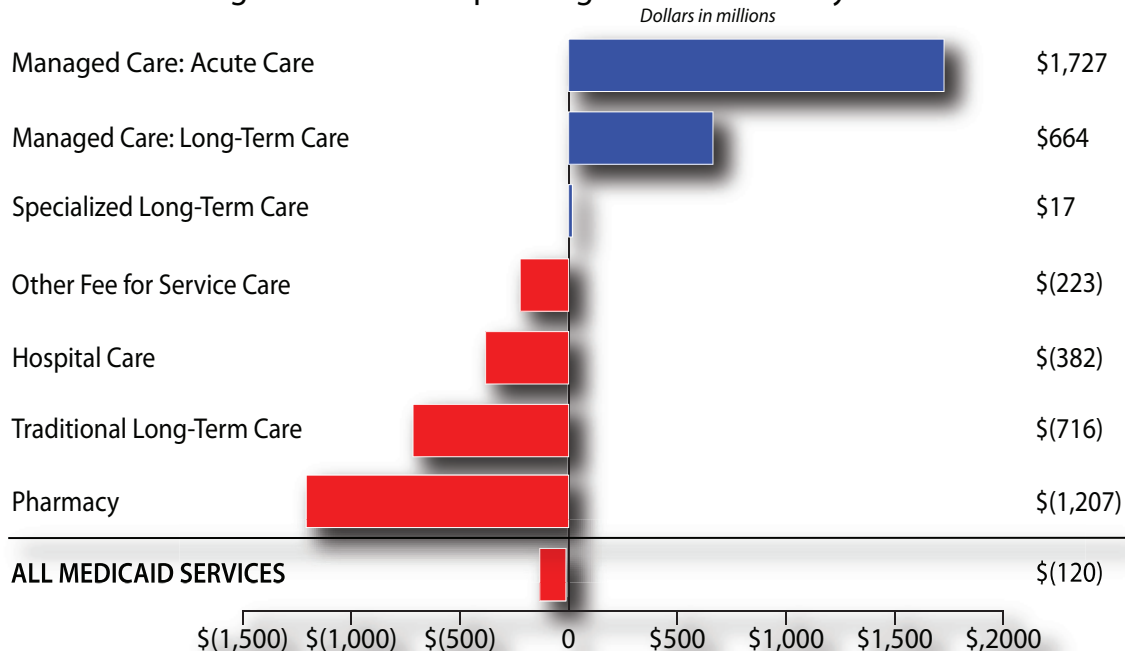


How Has Medicaid Spending on New York City Residents Changed Since Gov. Cuomo Implemented Savings Measures?

In January 2011, Governor Andrew Cuomo appointed a Medicaid Redesign Team to identify savings and limit yearly growth in statewide Medicaid funding to 4%.

Changes in Medicaid spending from state fiscal year 2010-2011 to 2011-2012*

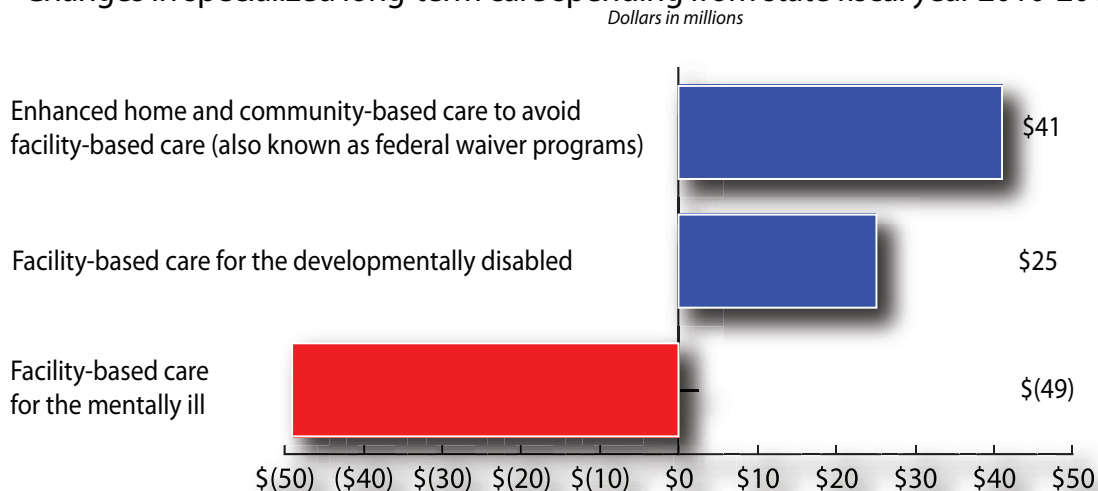


Total service spending is down by \$120 million or 0.4%.



Spending *increased* for two out of three types of specialized long-term care.
